

WHERE TO ENTER KINGS BEACH (NORTH ENTRANCE - NORTH **START** LAKE TAHOE VISITOR CENTER)

Your self-guided tour supports both entrances and offers clockwise and counterclockwise versions. We recommend following the clockwise route to keep the lake on your right throughout the tour.

START

SOUTH LAKE TAHOE (SOUTH ENTRANCE - TAHOE SOUTH VISITOR CENTER)

Don't worry — all the versions have all the same stories, just tailored to each entrance. One is not better than any other!

Be sure to have all of the versions downloaded ahead of time because there's no signal once in the park.

ITINERARIES

You can enjoy the tour at your own pace with the self-guided audio tour from Action Tour Guide.

This flexible tour can be completed in one day or spread over multiple days. Since it is valid for one year and offers unlimited usage, you don't have to worry about seeing everything in one visit.


ONE-DAY ITINERARY:

- Start your day early by entering the Lake Tahoe area through one of the main entrances (South Entrance recommended). Make sure to download the Action Tour Guide app and tour beforehand, as cell signals may be limited in certain areas around the lake.
- Stop at the Must-See points highlighted on the tour (marked in the tour as "Must-See"):
 - Pope Beach
 - Valhalla at Tallac Historic Site
 - Tallac Historic Site

- Fallen Leaf Lake
- Vikingsholm
- Rubicon Trail
- Enjoy a packed lunch at one of the designated picnic areas, such as Pope Beach or Valhalla at Tallac Historic Site Picnic Areas.
- Experience some of the moderate or challenging hikes if you feel confident (See Hikes Section).
- End your day by watching the sunset from a scenic viewpoint like
 Emerald Bay to witness the golden light painting the landscape.

TWO-DAY ITINERARY:

- **Day 1:** Follow the one-day itinerary mentioned above. Make sure you have the app and tour set up before you get to the entrance or continue where you left off.
- Day 1 Night: Return to an area with minimal light pollution for stargazing.
 Some recommended stargazing spots include:
 - Emerald Bay
 - Mount Tallac
 - Meeks Bay
- After a day of adventure, rest up and recharge for an exciting second day filled with exploration.
- Day 2: Return to the Lake Tahoe area and stop at the Must-See points highlighted on the tour (marked in the tour as "Must-See"):
 - Olympic Valley
 - King Beach State Recreation Area
 - Memorial Point Scenic Overlook
 - Sand Harbour
- Stop at Olympic Valley and the Alpine Base Area at Palisades Tahoe for hiking, mountain biking, scenic chairlift rides, and the aerial tram with stunning views. Olympic Valley also offers skiing, snowboarding, and a chance to explore the history of the 1960 Winter Olympics—perfect for adventure and history enthusiasts!
- Leave late in the evening to catch a stunning sunset from a scenic spot like Sand Harbor (reservation required) and enjoy your time exploring the natural beauty and attractions that Lake Tahoe has to offer!




KNOW BEFORE YOU GO



★ ENTRANCE FEES: There is no entrance fee!



RESERVATION: Some popular spots and attractions, like Sand Harbour, may require reservation especially during peak season, which is not included in the self-guided tour. Reserve here before your trip. Click here for more.





ROAD CLOSURES: Unexpected weather or construction can affect roads. While the tour is updated frequently to include detours, it cannot reflect up-to-the-minute updates. Several projects will impact traffic between Incline Village and Tahoe City this summer. Check before you leave.

PARK RULES AND SAFETY: Stay on designated trails, camp in designated areas, and respect wildlife and natural resources by following the local Camping Rules and Regulations. Follow all posted signs, guidelines and local Laws and Policies. Be familiar with the lake's Safety Guidelines.
